**Title of Report:** 2013 Annual Legal Services Trust Fund Program Report of the State Bar of California

**Statutory Citation:** Business and Professions Code sections 6222 and 6145

**Date of Report:** April 30, 2014

The State Bar of California has submitted its 2013 Annual Legal Services Trust Fund Program Report to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, and to the Assembly and Senate Judiciary Committees in accordance with Business and Professions Code sections 6222 and 6145.

In 1981, legislation was enacted by the State of California to expand the availability and improve the quality of existing free legal services in civil matters to indigent persons, and to initiate new programs that would provide such services. Under the provisions of Business and Professions Code Sections 6210-6228, interest earned on certain client trust accounts held by California attorneys is forwarded regularly to the State Bar. After the payment of administrative costs, the State Bar distributes eighty-five percent of the funds to qualified legal services projects and fifteen percent of the funds to qualified legal support centers.

This report consists of an operating statement of the Legal Services Trust Fund for the year ended December 31, 2013, notes to the operating statement, and grant disbursement schedules presented on a county by county basis. The operating statement summarizes the revenue sources of the LSTF funds, grant disbursements, and expenditures for administrative costs under Article 14 of the Business and Professions Code.

The notes to the operating statement presents the highlights of financial activities of the funds, and it is designed to provide readers with information that the State Bar's management believes to be necessary to an understanding of the report.

**Notes to Operating Statement for the Year Ended December 31, 2013**

(1) Legal Services Trust Fund Program

In 1981, legislation was enacted by the State of California to expand the availability and improve the quality of existing free legal services in civil matters to indigent persons, and to initiate new programs that would provide such services. Under the provisions of Business and Professions Code Sections 6210-6228, interest earned on certain client trust accounts held by California attorneys is forwarded regularly to the State Bar. After the payment of administrative costs, the State Bar distributes eighty-five percent of the funds to qualified legal services projects and fifteen percent of the funds to qualified legal support centers.

(2) Total Revenues

The State Bar's policy is to recognize revenue for the calendar year in which interest is received from the IOLTA accounts. This report includes other revenue sources that are distributed with IOLTA funds.

(3) Grant Allocations

Grants are allocated for a grant year beginning July 1 and ending June 30. Grant allocations are recognized as expense in the calendar year in which the Legal Services Trust Fund Commission awards the grants. The disbursement of grants is made in four equal installments, starting July of the grant year. Consequently, grant allocations for the 2013-14 grant year are treated as expenses in calendar year 2013.

The total amount allocated for grants each year is determined by considering the projected fund balance at July 1 (the beginning of the grant year) and the projected income and expenses for the grant year (July 1 to June 30). For the 2013-14 grant year, the State Bar approved an allocation of \$9,617,246 (a). The grant allocation for the 2013-14 grant year was calculated as follows:

(4) Administrative Costs

Operating expenses incurred to administer the program are deducted from the Trust Fund revenue. Administrative costs include direct costs and an interfund allocation. Direct costs include employee expenses for full-time and part-time staff, travel expenses, etc. The interfund allocation charged by the State Bar's General Fund to the program includes other costs, such as overhead, a share of administrative support, management, General Counsel, etc.

(5) Net Operating Surplus/(Deficit)

Since grants are recognized as expense in the year in which they are allocated rather than when they are actually paid out, total expenditures is a combination of calendar-year administrative costs and fiscal-year grant expenditures. "Net operating results" is the difference between that number and the total calendar-year revenues.

(6) Ending Fund Balance

The ending fund balance includes unrealized funds committed for grants in January through June 2014. All grant agreements provide that grant payments are to be made from funds received pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6212 and the income earned from investment of such funds, and that payment of grants is contingent upon the State Bar having sufficient funds on hand from such sources to make the scheduled payments.

(7) Grant Distribution

Grant Management. Section 6216 of the Statute sets forth the system for distributing grants as follows: "The State Bar shall distribute all moneys received under the program established by this article for the provision of civil legal services to indigent persons. The funds first shall be distributed 18 months from the effective date of this article, or upon such a date, as shall be determined by the State Bar, that adequate funds are available to initiate the program. Thereafter, the funds shall be distributed on an annual basis. All distributions of funds shall be made in the following order and in the following manner: Section 6216(a) To pay the actual administrative costs of the program, including any costs incurred after the adoption of this article and a reasonable reserve therefore.

Legal Services Project Grants. Section 6216(b) Eighty-five percent of the funds remaining after payment of administrative costs allocated pursuant to this article shall be distributed to qualified legal services projects. Distribution shall be by a pro rata county-by-county formula based upon the number of persons whose income is 125 percent or less of the current poverty threshold per county. For the purposes of

this section, the source of data identifying the number of persons per county shall be the latest available figures from the United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census. Projects from more than one county may pool their funds to operate a joint, multicounty legal services project serving each of their respective counties.

Section 6216(b)(1)(A) In any county which is served by more than one qualified legal services project, the State Bar shall distribute funds for the county to those projects which apply on a pro rata basis, based upon the amount of their total budget expended in the prior year for legal services in that county as compared to the total expended in the prior year for legal services by all qualified legal services projects applying therefore in the county. In determining the amount of funds to be allocated to a qualified legal services project specified in paragraph (2) of subdivision (a) Section 6213, the State Bar shall recognize only expenditures attributable to the representation of indigent persons as constituting the budget of the program. [See Schedules 1 and 1-A.]

Pro Bono Grants. 6216(b)(1)(B) The State Bar shall reserve 10 percent of the funds allocated to the county for distribution to programs meeting the standards of subparagraph (A) of paragraph (3) and paragraphs (1) and (2) of subdivision (b) of Section 6214 and which perform the services described in subparagraph (A) of paragraph (3) of Section 6214 as their principal means of delivering legal services. The State Bar shall distribute the funds for that county to those programs which apply on a pro rata basis, based upon the amount of their total budget expended for free legal services in that county as compared to the total expended for free legal services by all programs to meeting the standards of subparagraph (A) of paragraph (3) and paragraphs (1) and (2) of subdivision (b) of Section 6214 in that county. The State Bar shall distribute any funds for which no program has qualified pursuant hereto, in accordance with the provisions of subparagraph (A) of paragraph (1) of this subdivision. [See Schedule 1-A.]

Support Center Grants. 6216(c) Fifteen percent of the funds remaining after payment of administrative costs allocated for the purposes of this article shall be distributed equally by the State Bar to qualified support centers which apply for the funds. The funds provided to support centers shall be used only for the provision of legal services within California. Qualified support center that receive funds to provide services to qualified legal services projects from sources other than this article, shall submit and shall have approved by the State Bar a plan assuring that the services funded under this article are in addition to those already funded for qualified legal services projects by other sources.” [See Schedule 2.]
