1) **Registration:**

G Registration as a General Applicant:

This required registration is to be filed by law students not later than 90 days after beginning the study of law.

G Registration as an Attorney Applicant:

This required registration should be filed by all attorneys prior to the filing of an initial Application to Take the California Bar Examination or an Application for Determination of Moral Character. If filed late, processing of other applications will be delayed.

2) **G Application for Determination of Moral Character:**

This application initiates the moral character investigation required by Rule X of the *Rules Regulating Admission To Practice Law In California*. It is to be filed subsequent to the filing of the registration form and may be filed by a general registrant or attorney registrant at any time. Law students should file this application no later than the beginning of their last year of law study. The processing of these applications takes at least 6 - 8 months.

3) **G Application to Take the California Bar Examination:**

This application must be filed by anyone who wishes to take the California Bar Examination. If a registration form has not previously been filed, it must accompany the application to take the bar examination.

4) **G Application for Extension of Application for Determination of Moral Character:**

This application is required to maintain, in current status, an Application for Determination of Moral Character. It must be filed prior to the expiration of the previous moral character determination application.

PLEASE NOTE: July 2002 Bar Examination application packets are expected to be available in March 2002.

General Applicants: All applicants who have fulfilled the legal education requirements of Rule VII of the *Rules Regulating Admission To Practice Law In California (Rules)* but have not been admitted to practice law in any jurisdiction, including jurisdictions other than those in the United States, are classified as General Applicants, and admission will be to the General Bar Examination.

Attorney Applicants: All applicants who have been admitted to practice law before the highest court in any sister state in the United States or before the highest court of any state or county other than the United States are classified as Attorney Applicants.

TIMELY FILING DEADLINE: APRIL 1, 2002

To avoid payment of a late filing fee, an application must be received in the State Bar's Office of Admissions or postmarked on or before April 1, 2002.
