

VOLUNTARY RESIGNATION

I, _____, a member of the STATE BAR OF CALIFORNIA, having been admitted to practice in the State of California on the _____ day of _____, _____, do hereby tender my resignation as a member of said State Bar and relinquish the right to practice law in the State of California.

In tendering this voluntary resignation, I hereby declare that (1) to my knowledge, I am not currently the subject of any pending investigation for the commission of any felony or of a misdemeanor described in Business and Professions Code section 6068(o)(5); (2) there are no criminal charges currently pending against me for the commission of such felony or misdemeanor; and (3) I have not been convicted of any crime for which I have failed to notify the State Bar pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6068(o)(5).

I acknowledge that, upon tendering this resignation to the State Bar of California, I will be transferred to inactive membership of the State Bar and that, upon such transfer, I will be ineligible to practice law or to advertise or hold myself out as practicing or entitled to practice law. I further acknowledge that my resignation from the State Bar of California is not effective unless and until it is accepted by the California Supreme Court.

I understand that any false statement made by me in tendering this resignation may result in an order denying or vacating my resignation, that it is a cause for disbarment and that it may be punished as a contempt or a crime.
