SECTION	EXPLANATION
6.3	Language revised to conform this section to revised section 11.1, which allows members to demonstrate compliance in various ways acceptable to the State Bar.
11.1	Language revised to allow members to demonstrate compliance in various ways acceptable to the State Bar. For instance, members could report compliance online.
11.2	No substantive change intended. Language revised to clarify that a member must keep proof of compliance for one year after s/he provides the affirmative showing of compliance required by section 11.1.
12.1.2	Language revised to conform this section to revised section 11.1.
12.1.3	No substantive change intended. “Evidence” has been replaced with “proof” to conform section 12.1.3 with section 11.2.
12.1.4	Deleted as unnecessary, as failure to respond to a 60-Day Notice is not an additional reason for non-compliance.
12.2	The proposal specifies that the 60-Day Notice must inform members of the consequences of non-compliance, rather than specifying language to be quoted verbatim to accomplish this purpose.
