

**Additional Questions Received  
as of May 17, 2006, at 5:00 p.m. (end of question period)**

**1. Would you be willing to remove the FTR mixer?**

*Removal of the FTR mixer is preferred. We would like to connect the new digital signal processor directly to the PC, as long as that can be accomplished in a manner that will enable us to continue to digitally capture the court record using the FTR software. If that is not possible, retention of the FTR mixer would be acceptable.*

**2. Would you be willing to eliminate the FTR software altogether and use a different product for capturing the court record?**

*Not at this time. This RFP focuses on resolving the problems with our current audio hardware (mixer, amplifier, and teleconference interface). We do not contemplate using a different software product for digital recording at this time. However, the Vendor is encouraged to suggest in their proposal options for future improvements (see RFP section III. B. 6.; p. 9) including new hardware and software.*

**3. Is it required for the workers to have a background check before working on your site? If so, is there a charge for this?**

*No.*

**4. If the project needs to be done after hours, will we have to cover the cost for a security guard? If so, what rate would we be expected to pay?**

*Additional security required for after-hours work, if necessary, will be provided at no cost to the Vendor.*
