**APPLICATION FOR EVALUATION OF PRE-LEGAL EDUCATION**

Students who intend to begin the study of law may request an evaluation of whether they have obtained the pre-legal education necessary before beginning their law study, which is required by Section 6060 of the California Business and Professions Code. Associate of Applied Science degrees or Certificates of Completion in and of themselves do not fulfill the pre-legal education requirement, although credit for certain substantive classes taken within those programs may be given. Law schools may submit an evaluation application on behalf of potential students. To request an evaluation, the following materials must be submitted to **The State Bar of California, Office of Admissions, 845 S. Figueroa Street, Los Angeles, CA 90017-2515:**

1. A completed Evaluation of Pre-Legal Education form (see below);
2. A cashier's check or money order made payable to The State Bar of California for \$100 (**Personal checks will not be accepted**); and
3. All official college transcripts.
