



INSTRUCTIONS: CLEAR HEALTH PASS

As part of our commitment to the health and safety of applicants and staff at the California Bar Exam, all attendees must provide proof of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test before checking in.

- All bar exam sites will be using **Health Pass by CLEAR**, which provides secure, digital proof of vaccination or negative COVID-19 tests via the free CLEAR mobile app.

CLEAR Health Pass App Download link (only works from mobile device):

- All applicants, except those who were vaccinated internationally, must enroll with CLEAR before the exam to complete their COVID-19 pre-screening.
- **Health Pass by CLEAR** does not verify vaccination records acquired outside of the United States, so if you received your full vaccination status internationally, you must present your vaccine card in person at exam check-in.
- Once your vaccination record has been uploaded to the platform, it can typically take up to 30 minutes for your status to be verified.
- **All applicants uploading proof of vaccination must complete this process before attempting to access their Admittance Ticket on January 25.**

Health Pass by CLEAR

[Download the free CLEAR app](#) and complete the one-time enrollment process to verify your entry requirements.

Step 1: Download and enroll in CLEAR

1. Download the CLEAR app to your mobile device: <https://clear.app.link/EFAttendee200> and click the white Health Pass tile.
 - a. Select "Have a Code?" and enter the code EFATTENDEE200
2. Click "Enroll or verify you're in CLEAR" to create your CLEAR member account.
 - a. **New to CLEAR?** When prompted, enter your email address, phone number, and have your government-issued photo ID ready to complete enrollment. **You must use the email address listed as your preferred email address in the Applicant Portal.**
 - b. **Already a CLEAR member?** Use the email address associated with your membership (Please check to make sure it is the same as your preferred email address in the Applicant Portal) and snap a quick selfie to verify your identity.
3. Continue to follow prompts on the Entry Requirements page to securely confirm your proof of vaccination or negative test results. For those who do not have proof of vaccination, but instead will be uploading negative test results, that must be done in

advance of the exam, no sooner than 48 hours before the start of the first day of the exam (2/22/22) if using a PCR result and no sooner than 24 hours before the start of the first day of the exam is using an antigen result.

Vaccination

There are multiple options to digitally verify your COVID-19 vaccine; select the one that works best for you:

- Upload a photo of your CDC Vaccine Card.
 - When prompted to add your vaccination, select ‘add your vaccination card.’
 - Take a photo of your vaccination card and confirm your vaccine information.
 - Please note, the photo of your CDC card is used to generate a Health Pass. (Note: You will not be able to see the photo of the card once it is submitted and your HealthPass issued.)
 - Once confirmed, proceed to complete your Health Pass.
- Digitally link a vaccine from a health System or pharmacy.
 - The CLEAR app is integrated with select healthcare providers and pharmacies. Select your vaccine provider in the menu or by searching ‘other providers.’
 - Log in to your patient portal and follow instructions to securely link your account with CLEAR.
 - You may also link your CA Digital Vaccine record here: <https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/>
 - Check that your COVID-19 vaccine appears in your patient portal, if not we recommend you reach out to your provider directly.
 - Your results will link automatically. Do not try to resync your results.
 - Note, sync time varies by provider and may take up to 30 minutes.
 - Once synced, proceed to complete your Health Pass.
 - If you are unable to find your provider in search, CLEAR may not be able to link with them at this time.

COVID Test

For those who cannot provide proof of vaccination, you must provide proof of a negative polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test for COVID-19 within 48 hours of the start time for the first day of the exam on 2/22/22, or a negative antigen test within 24 hours of the start time for the first day of the exam. These tests must be performed at a test provider or laboratory. At-home tests are not accepted.

Both of these test result types can be uploaded to CLEAR. (Note: the timing for this requirement applies to all test sites.)

Within Health Pass, click “Add COVID test” in the entry requirements checklist to begin. Select your testing provider in the menu or by searching ‘other providers.’ Log in to your patient portal and follow instructions to securely link your account with CLEAR.

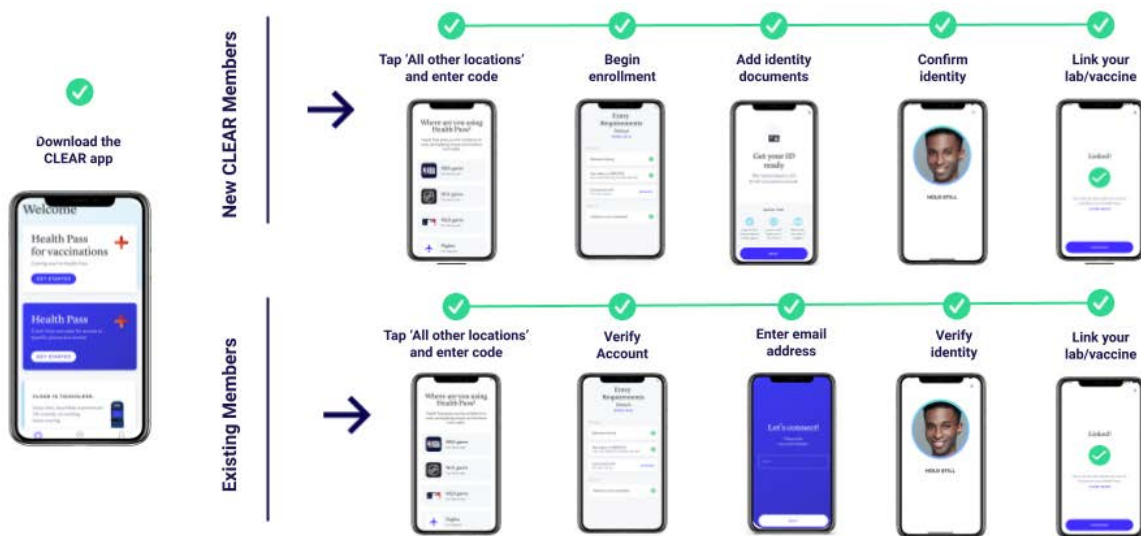
The CLEAR app is integrated with select healthcare providers and pharmacies. If you are unable to find your provider or unable to link a test, please be prepared to bring a physical copy of your test results and your ID to the staff table at the exam site.

Step 2: Before arriving to the event, complete your Health Pass for faster entry at check-in.

1. Open the CLEAR app and click the white Your Pass tile.
2. Confirm your identity with a quick selfie.
3. Tap “Open Health Pass” to get your result. Green means you’re good to go!

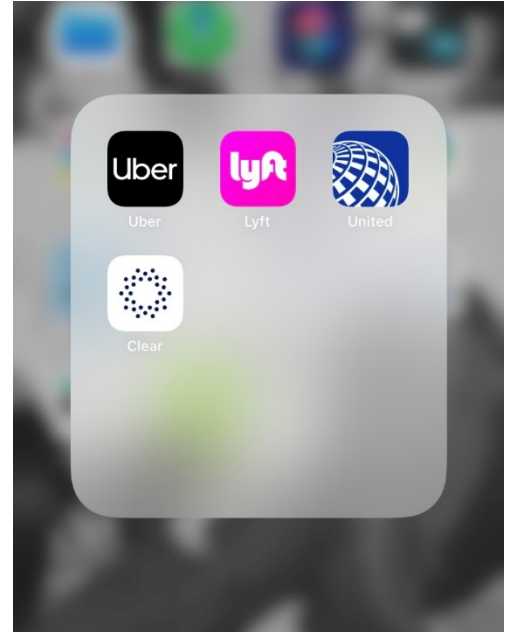

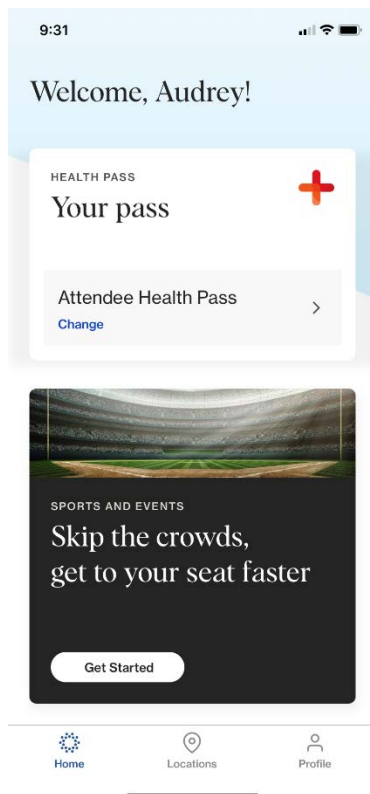
Step-by-step walk-through

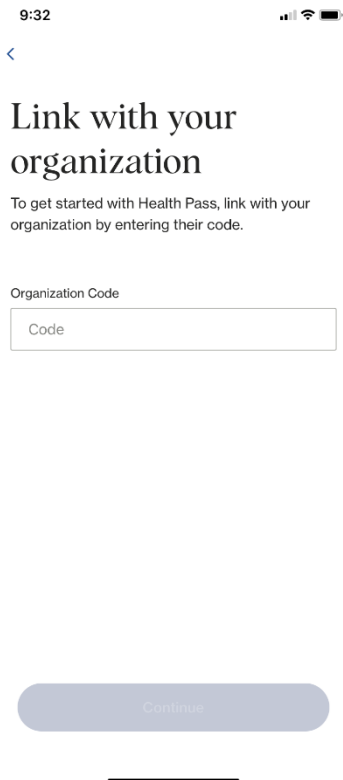
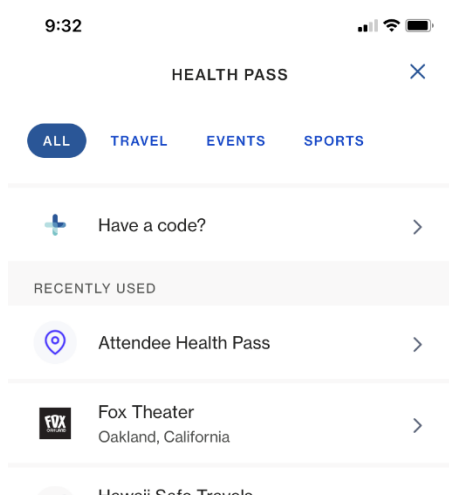


To link to the bar exam, navigate to the white tile labeled Health Pass.



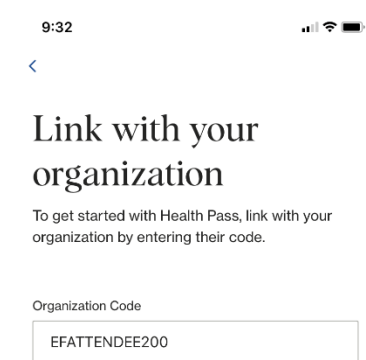

Navigate to the "ALL" tab and choose "Have a code?"

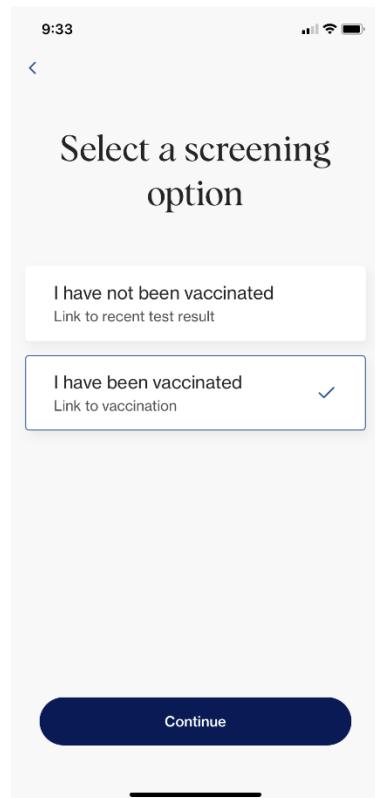

Enter the code for the bar exam – EFATTENDEE200



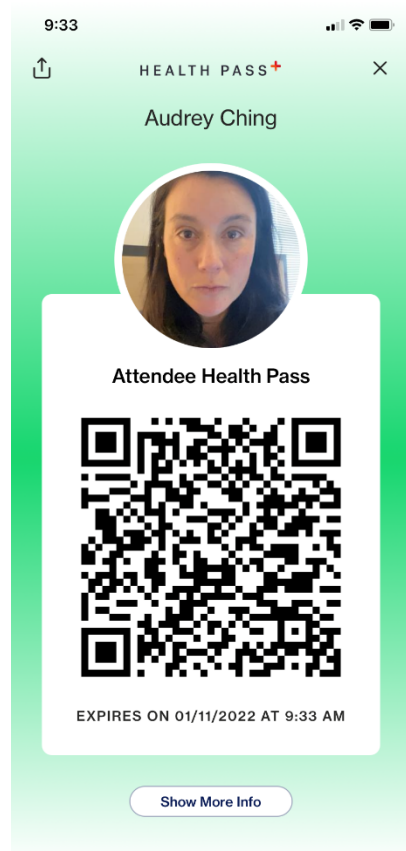
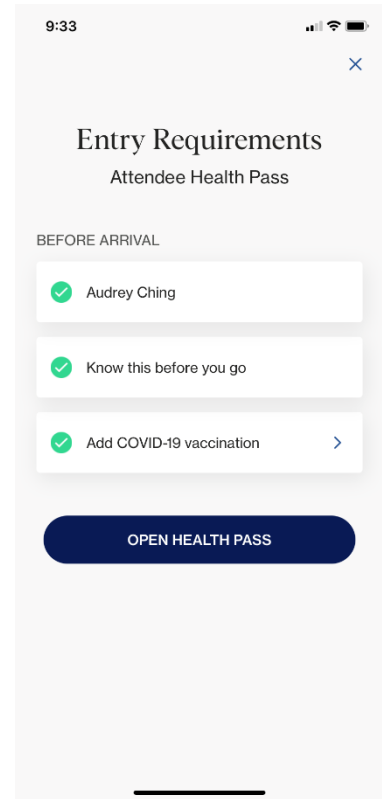
You will then be shown our two options for entry into the bar exam.

If you have already linked your vaccination information in CLEAR, your vaccine information will pop up, if not you will have to click in and add (see instructions on page 2).

You will also have to read through the “Know this before you go” section.



Once all your information is entered, you may open your green health pass for the bar exam. It will be called “Attendee Health Pass.”

Please note that your health pass status expires after 24 hours, but this is only in reference to linking your information to the bar exam Health Pass, not your vaccine information itself. All you need to do before the exam is to link to our code – EFATTENDEE200, once more.
