

If your payment is not received during this two-month period, the State Bar Board of Trustees will recommend to the California Supreme Court that you be suspended from the practice of law effective July 1, 2015.

Please be advised that if you are suspended for nonpayment, it will become a part of your official State Bar membership record and notice of such suspension will be listed on the State Bar's website. Also, once suspended, your fees and penalties will continue to accrue, and your suspension will remain in effect until the State Bar receives payment of all outstanding fees, penalties or costs.

In order to avoid suspension, please remit payment in the enclosed envelope. After **May 8, 2015**, the State Bar will only accept payment by a credit card accepted by the State Bar, in cash or by cashier's check, money order, bank certified check, or wire transfer. 
