1. Attachment A: A1 Annual Sponsorship Fee – can you clarify what this is?

Any additional source of revenue (such as a rebate) that we may consider.

2. Attachment D: Section T mentions CME credit. What does CME stand for? Should that be CLE?

CME stands for Continuing Medical Education, it is a type of CLE.

3. The free events that are discussed. Are those live events or on-demand? A mix?

The free events are on-demand programs.

4. Can you provide an estimate on the # of live events each year, with the typical length and average attendance?

Approximately 75 live events from 1 – 3 days in length with attendance from 50 – 700 people. NOTE: the Annual Meeting is not included in these numbers.

5. Will you sign a non-disclosure agreement (NDA)?

Per the RFP:

We will not sign any vendor NDA without modifying it to provide for the legal and administrative requirements for the California Public Records Act which the Bar is bound to. If this is of interest, submit your NDA with a clear intent to proceed this way. If this is not of interest, please ensure that your proposal does not include privileged, confidential or trade secret information.
