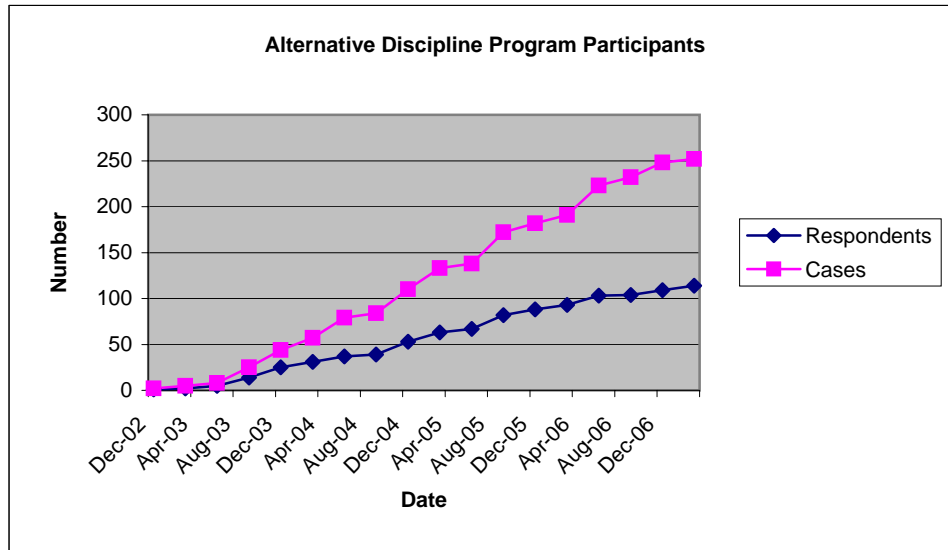

**State Bar Court Developments
(May 2007)**

1. Judge Donald F. Miles was sworn in as Judge of the State Bar Court. Judge Miles serves as a Hearing Judge in Los Angeles and was appointed by the Governor.

2. As of April 26, 2007, 18 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program. At this time, there are 205 respondents who have either been referred to the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program (ADP), or are being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program, or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 205 respondents involve 394 matters in the State Bar Court.
