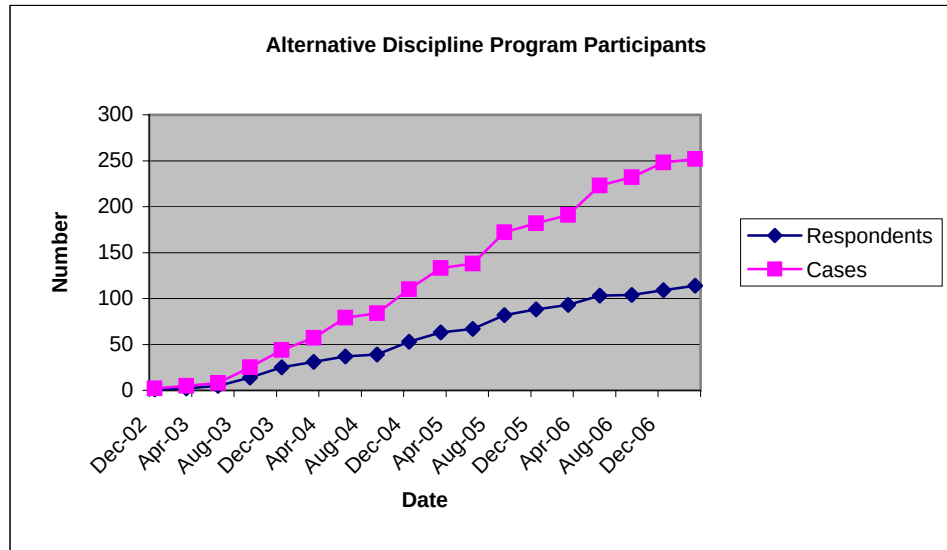
Authorized vs. Actual (Year-to-date)

**State Bar Court Developments
(July 2007)**

1. Judge Lucy Armendariz was sworn in as Judge of the State Bar Court. Judge Armendariz serves as a Hearing Judge in San Francisco and was appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. Judge Armendariz is filling the unexpired term of Judge Joann Remke, who was elevated to Presiding Judge in November.
2. Effective June 1, 2007, Colin Wong was appointed as the Chief Administrative Officer of the State Bar Court. Colin was formerly with the General Counsel's Office.
3. As of June 29, 2007, 21 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program. At this time, there are 214 respondents who have either been referred to the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program (ADP), or are being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program, or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 214 respondents involve 415 matters in the State Bar Court.
