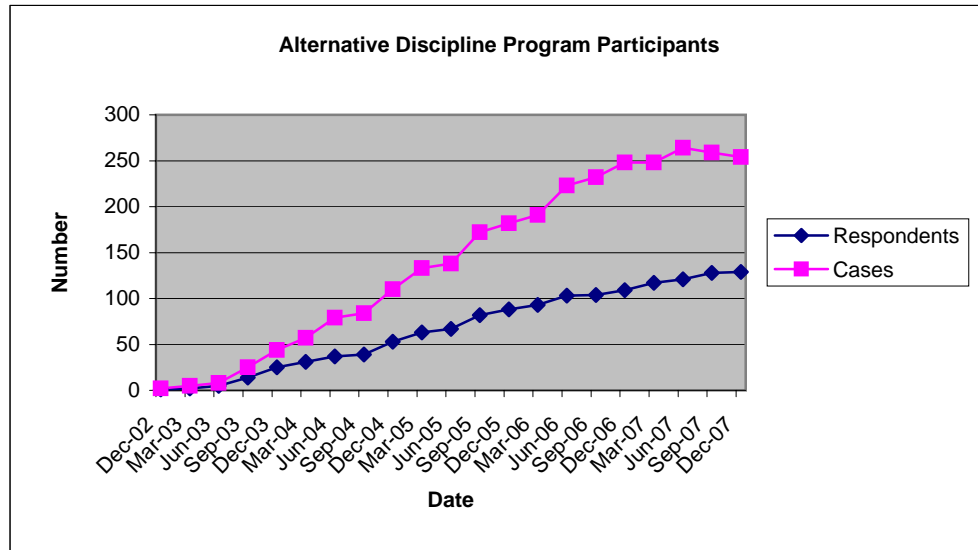

(March 2008)**

1. As of February 19, 2008, 38 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program. These 196 respondents involve 375 matters in the State Bar Court.
