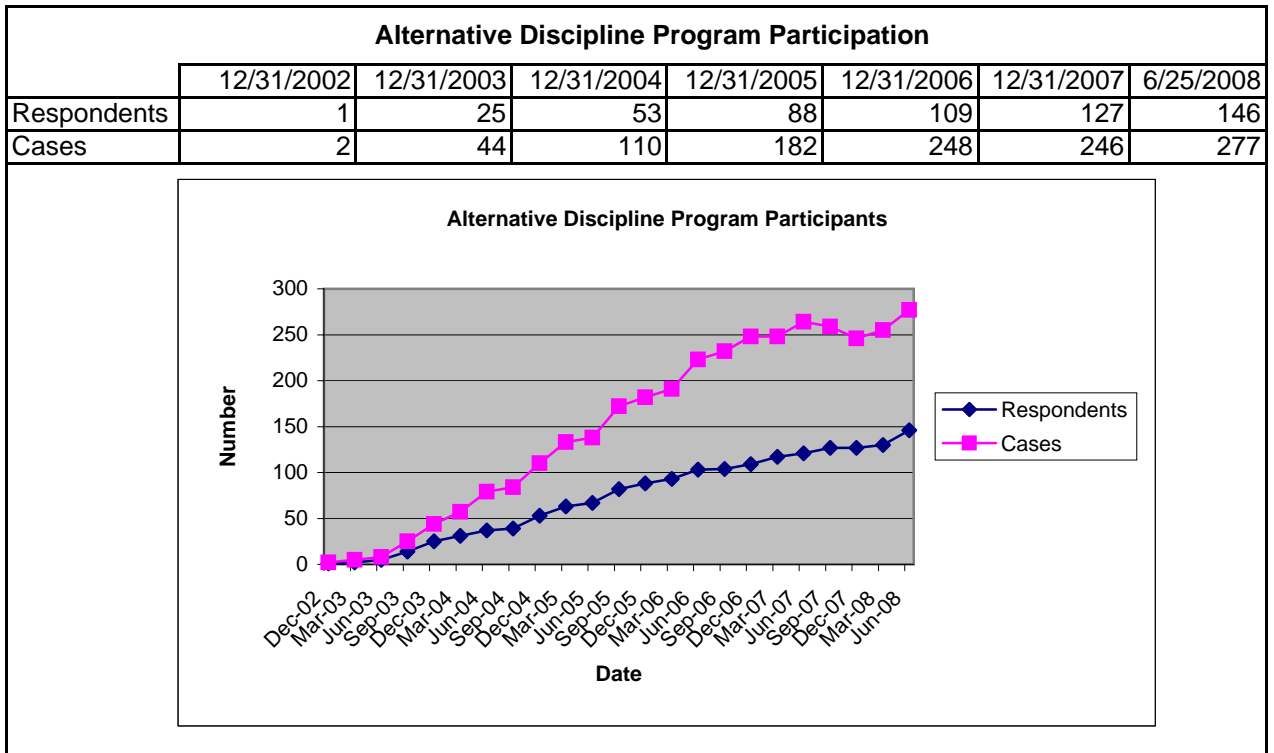

* The 2008 budget for the State Bar Court was prepared assuming that vacant positions existing as of the date of the budget's adoption (July of 2007) would remain vacant for a period of time in 2008. For the Court, an 8% salary savings rate was factored into its salary and benefits line items. The majority of the salary savings was assumed to result from the vacancies of 2 hearing judges and several attorney positions which were not filled. Since these positions were filled before the end of 2007, the budgeted salary savings did not occur.

**State Bar Court Developments
(July 2008)**

1. Judicial recruitment for two State Bar Court judicial positions has commenced. The Applicant Evaluation and Nomination Committee (“AENC”) is currently reviewing applications for one Hearing Judge and one Review Judge. The Hearing Judge is to be appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly; the Supreme Court will appoint the Review Judge. Terms of the appointed judges are to commence on November 1, 2008 and will run for six years.
2. After 13 years of service to the State Bar Court, Review Judge Madge Watai has retired from the State Bar Court. Judge Watai’s last day was June 26, 2008. Former Presiding Judge Ronald Stovitz has been appointed to serve as pro tem judge in the Review Department until a replacement is appointed by the Supreme Court.
3. As of June 26, 2008, 48 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court’s Alternative Discipline Program (“ADP”). At this time, there are 200 respondents who are either being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program for participation in the ADP or have been accepted into the State Bar Court’s Program. These 200 respondents involve 380 matters in the State Bar Court.
