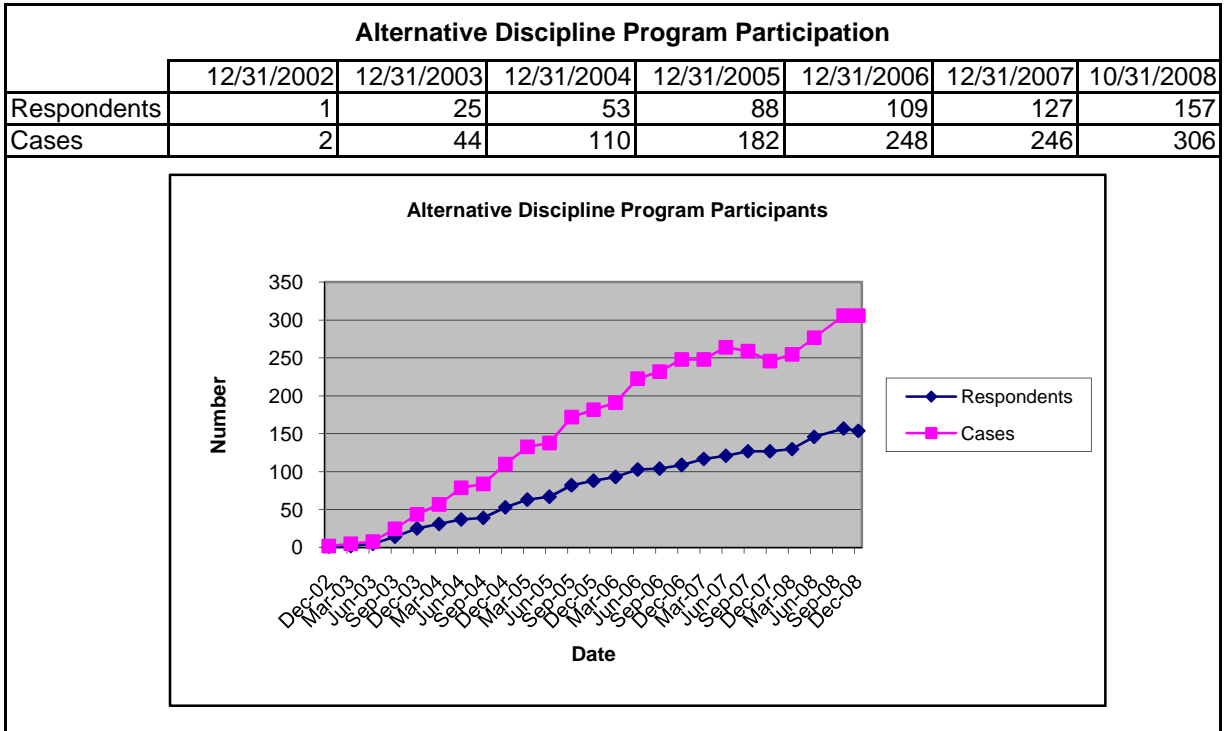

**State Bar Court Developments  
(March 2009)**

1. The State Bar Court has commenced posting Notices of Disciplinary Charges and responses online. The court expects to have all notices posted by mid-March, 2009.
2. As of February 18, 2009, 56 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program ("ADP"). At this time, there are 186 respondents who are either being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program for participation in the ADP or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 186 respondents involve 372 matters in the State Bar Court.
