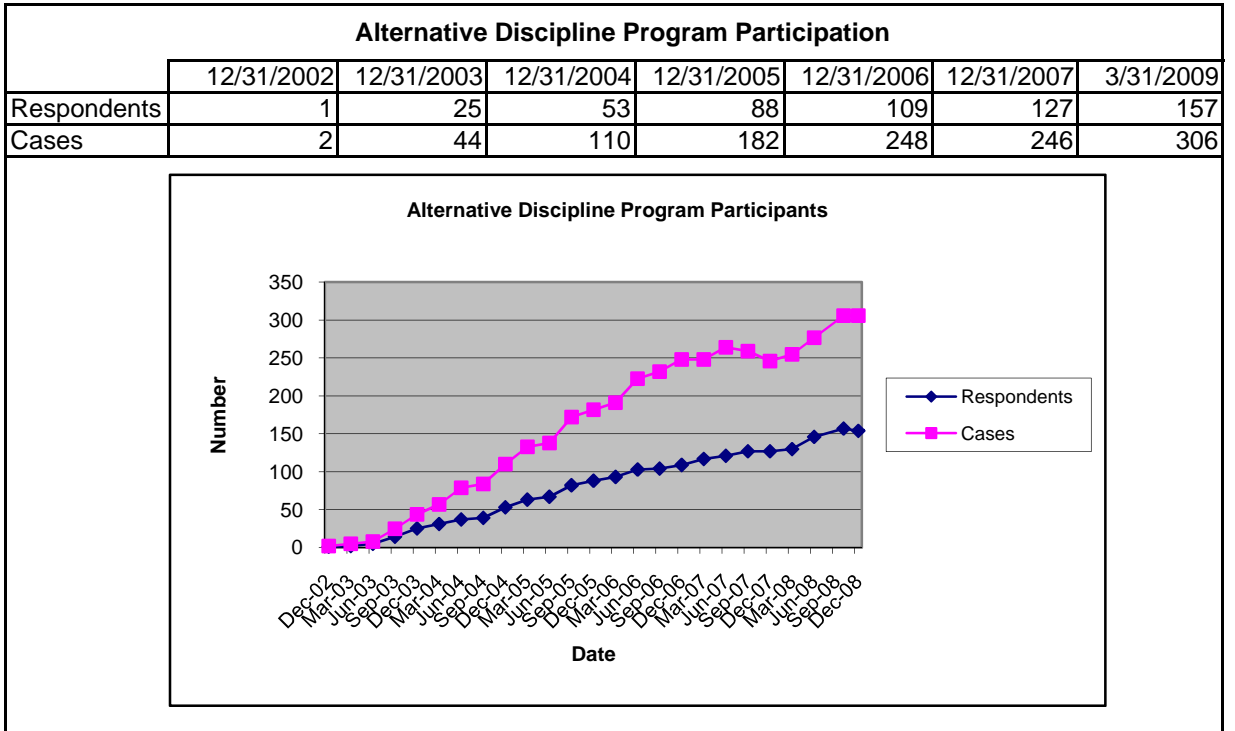

(May 2009)**

1. As of April 23, 2009, 62 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program ("ADP"). At this time, there are 183 respondents who are either being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program for participation in the ADP or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 183 respondents involve 372 matters in the State Bar Court.
