2 called to the podium, and if there are any intervening  
3 speakers, we will ask that you restate your name so that  
4 your comments can be properly attributed.

5           If you have any written materials that have not  
6 yet been submitted, please give them to Mimi Lee of the  
7 State Bar Staff, who is sitting there and just raised her  
8 hand, and if there's anyone here who has not signed in, we  
9 also ask that you sign in with Mimi before being called to  
10 speak.

11           The public hearing has been authorized by the  
12 Board of Governors Committee on Regulation and Admissions,  
13 which oversees the work of the Commission. The Commission  
14 is a subentity of the Board of Governors.

15           This public hearing, as well as the 60-day public  
16 comment period on the proposed rules, which ends on  
17 March 12, 2010, has been authorized by the Board.

18           Well, let me introduce to you the members of the  
19 Commission and the Staff here. To my far left is Raul  
20 Martinez, a member of the Commission. Next to him is Robert  
21 Kehr, also a member of the Commission. To my right is Kevin  
22 Mohr, our consultant. Next to Mimi is Randy Difuntorum, and  
23 that is Mimi Lee, as I indicated before.

24           It's my understanding that we have one speaker who  
25 had signed up to talk, but, apparently, so far he has not

1 arrived, and so we'll wait a short period of time to see if  
2 he arrives or if any other speaker is present. So we can go  
3 off the record now.

4 (Proceedings recessed briefly.)

5 MR. SONDHEIM: We're back on the record again, and  
6 we've been waiting approximately 40 minutes to see if  
7 anybody is interested in making any comments. We've also  
8 tried to contact the one person who we believed might be  
9 here at the hearing, but so far we have not been successful  
10 in directly contacting that person, even though we've left a  
11 message for that person.

12 Unless there's anybody in the room here who would  
13 like to speak, I'm going to adjourn our public hearing.  
14 Seeing no one who desires to speak, we will adjourn the  
15 public hearing. We've looked outside to see if there is  
16 anybody on their way, and there appears to be no one, and I  
17 want to thank all the persons who have attended here for  
18 coming, and it's now about 1:43.

19 THE REPORTER: It's about 10:12.

20 MR. SONDHEIM: Excuse me. Let me try that again.

21 THE REPORTER: About 10:12.

22 MR. SONDHEIM: 10:12, and we're going to adjourn  
23 the public hearing. Have a good morning.
