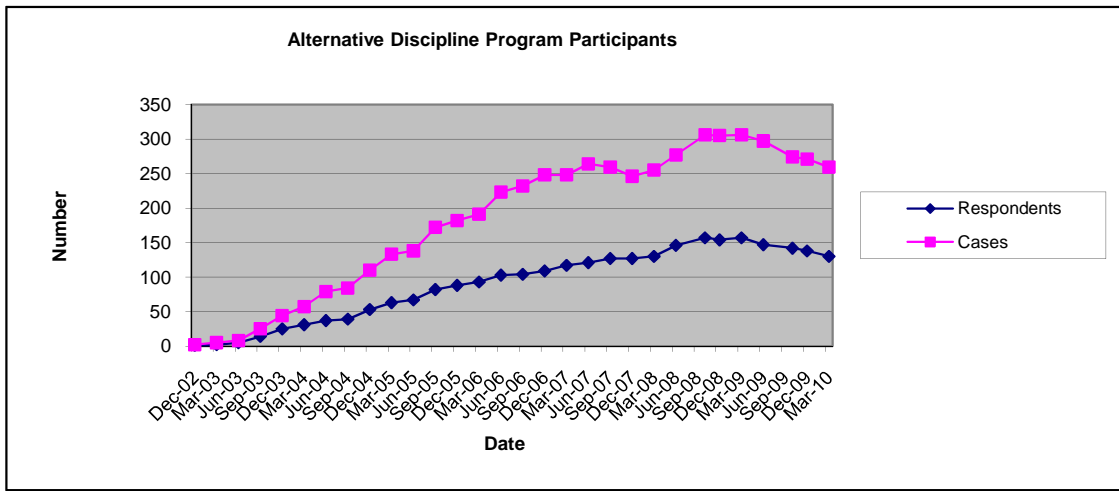

**State Bar Court Developments
(May 2010)**

As of April 30, 2010, 99 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program ("ADP"). At this time, there are 147 respondents who are either being evaluated by the Lawyer Assistance Program for participation in the ADP or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 147 respondents involve 275 matters in the State Bar Court.
