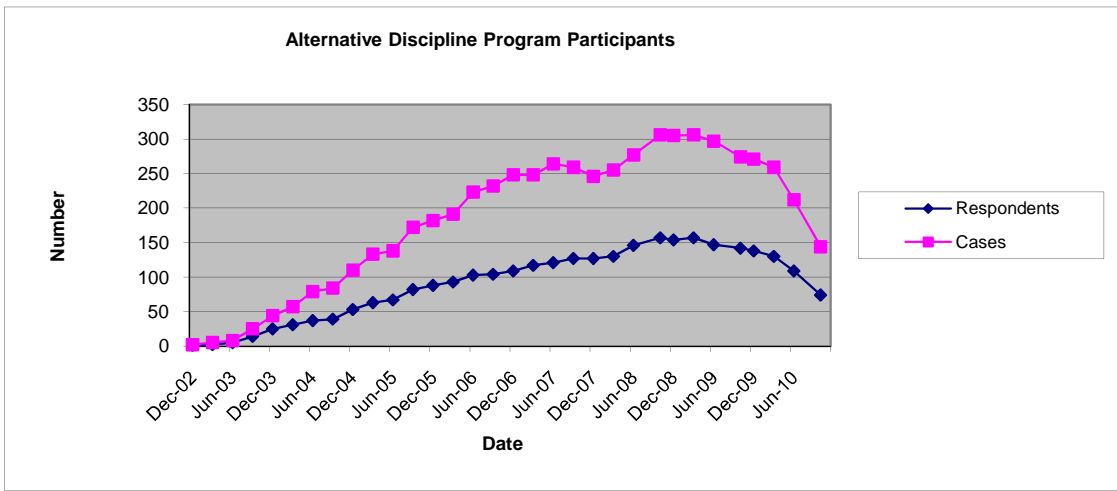

## **State Bar Court Developments (November 2010)**

- Judges Judith Epstein and Richard Honn were reappointed by the Supreme Court for six-year terms. The Senate Committee on Rules reappointed hearing judge Lucy Armendariz for a six-year term.
  
- As of October 26, 2010, 145 respondents have successfully completed the State Bar Court's Alternative Discipline Program ("ADP"). At this time, there are 75 respondents who or have been accepted into the State Bar Court's Program. These 75 respondents involve 144 matters in the State Bar Court.
