CREDIT FOR LAW STUDY AFTER PASSING THE FIRST-YEAR LAW STUDENTS' EXAM

An applicant who passes the exam within the first three consecutive administrations of becoming eligible to take the exam, as determined by the State Bar, will receive credit for all law study completed to the date of the administration of the exam passed, subject to any restrictions otherwise covered by the [Admission Rules](#). An applicant who does not pass the exam within the first three consecutive administrations of becoming eligible to take the exam, but who subsequently passes the exam, will only receive credit for one year of law study. If you are unsure of how much recognized law study you have completed, you may request a legal evaluation through your Applicant Portal.
